FUTURE JACKSON DOG PARK



Feedback received in the Hasmer Lake Park Plan Public Information Survey, the 2021 Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Plan, and the 2025 Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Plan Community Survey highlighted a strong desire for a dedicated community dog park. In 2024, Cedar Run Park was approved as the official site. This 26-acre park features open green space and several trails, making it an ideal location. Planned improvements include the removal of dead trees, expansion of trails, and the addition of separated fenced areas for large and small dog breeds. Construction is scheduled to begin this fall, with the park's grand opening anticipated in 2026.

As we move this exciting project forward, we are seeking community support to help bring the dog park to life through funding and partnerships. Together, we can create a space that both residents and their furry friends will enjoy for years to come.
