

The primary purpose of the Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan for the Village of Jackson is to guide the preservation, acquisition, and development of land for park, recreation, and

related open space purposes as needed to satisfy the wide range of active and passive recreational needs of Village residents, and to protect and enhance the important natural resources located throughout the community as a whole.
