DEPARTMENT AND PARK UPDATES

5 year Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (AKA – CORP)

In 2021, the Village Board passed the Comprehensive Outdoor and Recreation Plan for 2021 - 2025. The plan provided guidance and direction for the Parks and Recreation department to maintain, improve, and grow Village parks and open spaces and recreation programming. Staff has been hard at work seeking community feedback, evaluating park spaces, and updating the plan for 2026 - 2030. We anticipate having the plan approved this fall and are looking forward to all of the great improvements we can make moving forward. This plan is expected to include the development of Hasmer Lake, increased program opportunities, walking paths and trails, and so much more!

Hasmer Lake Park Development

The Hasmer Lake Park Project is being proposed for next year's budget. If approved, engineering will begin on the project and staff will also begin searching for funding sources to reduce the financial impact on the Village. The park would then begin construction in 2027.



Cedar Run Dog Park Update



The long wait is nearing its end as we anticipate the park to open this fall once the majority of grass has been established. Crews have done such a great job with the park providing so many opportunities for our community members and their furry friends to safely enjoy the park. Once the park is open, please make sure you take some time to review the rules of the park before entering to help keep all guests as safe as possible!

COMMUNITY CENTER - GENERAL INFORMATION

General Policies

1. **Residents** are persons who reside within and pay their property taxes to the Village of Jackson.
2. **Non-residents** are persons who reside in and pay taxes to any community outside of the Village of Jackson.
3. **Memberships** are non-refundable and non-transferable.
4. **Family** is considered 2 adults living in the same household and their immediate children. Once a child turn 18 years old they cannot be considered in a family unless they are a full time (12+ credits) student.
5. **Senior** includes anyone 60+
6. Anyone **14 - 17 years of age** must show high school ID or have a legal guardian present. A legal guardian must sign the registration form.
7. Memberships do not include programs, but you do not need a membership to register for a program.
8. **CANCELLATIONS** - If class size does not meet the minimum listed requirements, the class may be cancelled. If a cancellation occurs due to class size, you will be offered a full refund or a transfer to another class with the same fee. We will make every effort to combine classes to avoid cancellations.
9. **Weather Related Cancellations** - We rarely close due to weather but if we do, you can learn about cancellations on our Facebook page or the local news channel. Weather cancellations are out of our control and we may not be able to offer make up classes in the event of a cancellation.
10. **Refund** requests made at least (2) weeks prior to the start date of the program and will be considered for a full refund minus a processing fee. A 50% service fee will be applied to any cancellations made 13 days prior to the start date of a class. NO REFUNDS will be granted once a program has begun. Please allow (3) weeks for processing.
9. **Social Media, Video, and Photography Policy** - During programs and events we will periodically take pictures or videos to use for our promotional materials. By participating in events/programs, you understand you are giving us permission to be used in photos and or videos in multi-media publications. If you do not want your picture/video taken or used in publications or advertisements, please let us know immediately when you see a Jackson Park & Rec Staff or Volunteer taking pictures or video.

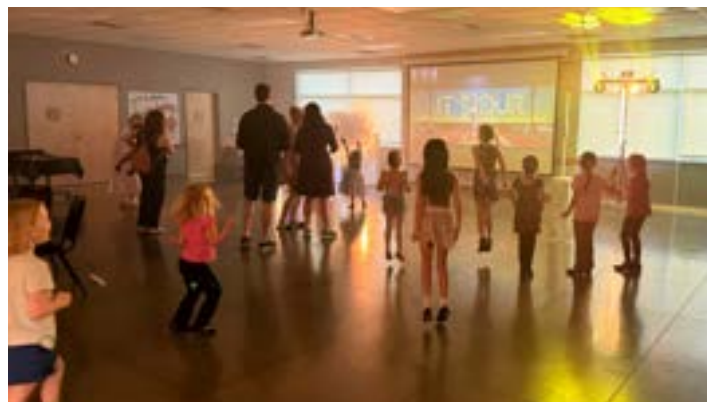

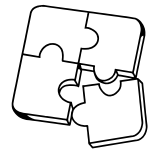

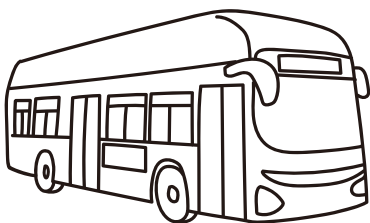
