



Exciting JPR Projects for Jackson

Jackson has Several Exciting Parks & Recreation Projects in the Works

All of these projects have been identified in the Parks, Recreation & Open Space Plan, which included community input, project/amenity ranking and JPR Staff & Commission recommendations.



Jackson Community Center Expansion

This project will add approx. 14,000 sq. ft. to the existing building. There will be additions on the west and east sides, additional storage and workspace, a secured front desk area, several maintenance items and most importantly, increased security

throughout the building.

Hasmer Lake Park

Acquiring (2) properties adjacent to the DNR Hasmer Lake Access was a huge accomplishment for the Village. Preservation of our natural resources and areas only happens once before residential or commercial development happens. In 2023, a Park Master Plan was approved to use as a guideline for park development in the future. It has the potential to be an amazing gateway to our community!

Jackson Community Dog Park

We have just begun the feasibility and design phase for the Jackson Dog Park project. Keep an eye on the JPR Facebook Page and emails as we will be holding a public input and information meeting in conjunction with our Friends of Jackson Parks & Recreation group.


