

FUTURE JACKSON DOG PARK

Recently, the Hasmer Lake Park Plan Public Information Community Survey brought the surface the importance of a Dog Park in the Jackson Community. The creation of a Dog Park was also prevalent in the 2021 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan.



a Dog Park was also prevalent in the 2021 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan. Ideas, locations and important components have been discussed at length over the years, but never really materialized. The primary potential site to be considered is Cedar Run Park, a 26-acre park located within in the Village, on Cedar Creek. The park is mainly open space with a few trails and an open area in the center. Due to parking and limited recreational opportunities, the park is underutilized. It does however, offer most of the base requirements to create an exceptional dog park; wooded areas, open space, trails and the Village already owns it. The timing for presenting this vision could not be better. Cedar Run Park is located at the corner of Eagle Drive and Hickory Lane. Coincidentally, the Hickory Lane Road Construction Project is tentatively scheduled for 2025. If the Dog Park project is parlayed with the construction project, it could provide cost-effective parking options and added amentities for the dog park.

WE Welcome YOUR INPUT and support!

We are in the beginning phase's of the project and are working with MSA Consultants to have a design and proposal to the Village Board by the end of the year, with construction complete in 2025. But we need your help, through our Friends Group, we will be creating a sub-committee to help with final amenity details, on going support and volunteer efforts to create this amazing dog park and keep it amazing for many years.
