COVID-19 & The JACKSON COMMUNITY CENTER

As of May 14, 2020, the Village of Jackson is following the Washington/Ozaukee Health Department's (WOPHD) "BLUEPRINT FOR REOPENING WASHINGTON & OZAUKEE COUNTIES" as a guide (which can be found in its entirety on the WOPHD website). The Jackson Parks & Recreation Department is implementing the following for the safety of our participants, rental users and staff:

- * Social distancing practices will be observed for all programs, long-term
- * A Hand Santizing Station will be provided in the lobby
- * Sadly, there will be no congregating in the lobby at this time
- * Providing Basic Face masks for participants as requested
- * Rental Groups at 25% of capacity or a max. of 50 utilizing only the Gathering Hall, Games Room and Gymnasium
- * Rental Violations may result in loss of deposit.
- * Programs will be run at a 9 participant to 1 instructor ratio (except for gym held programs as stated in guide)
- * Fitness Center, Open Walking Club and the Indoor Pickleball participants will need to reserve time slots through the registration process
- * All procedures will be re-evaluated mid-summer and as new local, State and Federal guidelines are made available.
- * Boys & Girls Club will utilize West Entrance (off Jackson Drive) for program drop off and pickup * Tot Time Participants will enter at the East Entrance off of the parking lot
- * No Spectators
